

# DoT Secy directs BBNL, BSNL to take disciplinary action against officials for BharatNet faults

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Telecom Secretary Aruna Sundararajan has directed state-owned BBNL and BSNL to initiate disciplinary action against officials who failed to fix non-functional broadband equipment under the ambitious BharatNet project, sources said.

This is the second time in little over a month that Sundararajan has flagged the issue as Bharat Broadband Network Ltd (BBNL) and BSNL are yet to take steps that could have led to disciplinary action or filing of "chargesheet" against the officers who are accountable for maintenance of broadband lines under the BharatNet.

The secretary has sent a strongly-worded communication, dated December 14, to the heads of Bharat Broadband Network Ltd and BSNL after she came to know that broadband equipment in over 50,000 village panchayats are non-functional, the sources said.

Under BharatNet government has enabled over 1.21 lakh panchayats with optical fibre cable-based high speed broadband network. Citing the communication, the sources said the secretary has called for "chargesheet/ disciplinary action be initiated against the supervisory officers in BBNL responsible".

It is regrettable that both CMD BSNL and CMD BBNL have not complied with the directions issued on November 14 as there is yet to be any improvement with respect to the non-functional equipment, the sources said quoting the communication.

As per the communication, dated December 14, Sundararajan has also pointed out that the matters of non-functional BharatNet lines have been mentioned in Parliament and critical observations have also been made by the Prime Minister's Office in several meetings.

BSNL is a vendor of Bharat Broadband Network Ltd with respect to rolling out BharatNet project. Queries sent to Bharat Broadband Network Ltd and BSNL remained unanswered.

The sources said BSNL has submitted its response to the secretary wherein it has stated that operation and maintenance mechanism put in place by Bharat Broadband Network Ltd has no mechanism to alert ground staff about faults.

## Govt did not seek Urjit's resignation: FM

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Finance Minister Arun Jaitley Tuesday said the government did not seek resignation of Urjit Patel as RBI Governor over differences on some issues, and went on to cite how central bank heads were made to resign under prime ministers Jawaharlal Nehru and Indira Gandhi and when Yashwant Sinha was finance minister.

### GOVT-RBI RELATIONSHIP LIKE OF 'HUSBAND-WIFE': MANMOHAN

Former prime minister Manmohan Singh Tuesday said the relationship between the government and the RBI is like of "husband-wife" and the difference of opinions must be resolved in a manner that the two institutions work in harmony.

The comments came against the backdrop of Urjit Patel resigning as RBI Governor earlier this month amid a tussle between the central bank and the finance ministry on matters ranging from the appropriate size of reserves the central bank must hold to the easing of lending norms for sectors such as small and medium enterprises.

Talking to reporters on the sidelines of the launch of his six-volume series of books titled 'Changing India' here, Singh, who is also a former RBI governor, said one has to respect the autonomy and the independence of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

"Sarkar ki unse koi istife ki apeksha nahi thi (The government did not seek Patel's resignation)," Jaitley said when asked about Patel's resignation at 'Agenda Aaj Tak' programme here.

The government had cited the never-used-before provision of the RBI Act that gives it powers to issue directions to the Governor, to get the central bank to discuss its areas of concerns.

Two board meetings after that were "cordial" and decisions were taken on three-four issues while there were also some on which no decision was taken, he said, adding the issue of paring of some of RBI's over Rs 9 lakh crore reserves after deciding on an appropriate size of buffer was decided to be referred to an expert committee.

While the committee was decided to be formed in the RBI board meeting held on November 19, a consensus on the composition eluded till Patel resigned.

Jaitley said the expert committee would be announced in few days time.

"So if you are saying that raising these issues is an infringement on autonomy, this is wrong," he said.

He then went on to cite past RBI governors who had resigned.

"The first governor to resign (was in) 1955 when (Prime Minister) Pt Jawaharlal Nehru wrote to Governor B Rama Rau (that) economic policy is to be framed by Government of India (and) monetary policy is to be framed by you. But your other policies like credit policies have to be in support of the government's economic policies. And if are suggesting you would resign, I am unable to advise you to the contrary." So he resigned," he said.

Indira Gandhi got Sarukkai Jagannathan to resign after he refused to give an enhanced loan to Maruti.

"Yashwant Sinha, who became the high priest of RBI autonomy, during the Chandra Shekhar government called (RBI) Governor R N Malhotra and said I want your resignation," he added.

Former finance minister P Chidambaram, Jaitley said, was "not on speaking terms with two Governors during his tenure."

Many central banks around the world maintain 8 per cent of gross assets as reserves while conservative ones maintain at 13-14 per cent. RBI maintains it at 28 per cent, Jaitley said.

"In 2013 they said that you have Rs 1.46 lakh crore in excess you give. Then no one said that it is raiding the Reserve Bank," he said.

Defending his government's demands from the Reserve Bank to address certain issues including liquidity or fund problem in certain sectors, he said that there is no threat to the autonomy of the central bank.

Patel, who was brought in by Prime Minister Narendra Modi-government in 2016 after a second term was denied to outspoken former IMF chief economist Raghuram Rajan, in a surprise move resigned as RBI Governor on December 11.

Many blamed the pressure brought by the government on the central bank to ease lending restrictions and release more of its capital to bolster the economy for Patel's resignation.

## Goan co feels 'left out' by State government

**PANJIM:** Despite all the talk of Make in Goa, the state government has awarded a 'healthy heart' project contract for STEMI Goa to a non-Goan company even though an advanced, cost-effective and much superior solution has been developed and implemented by Kallows, a company headquartered in Goa, who had previously been awarded the tender for the project.

Addressing a press conference, Kallows' Managing Director, Gajanan Nagarsekar said the STEMI Goa program launched by the Government of Goa a few days back is not utilising the minimum acceptable standard of ECG recording for their programme. "At first glance one can see that the technical specification is improper. A STEMI cardiac program anywhere in the world is run using a 12-channel ECG not a 4-channel ECG machine like the one selected by the Goa government. Any cardiologist worth his salt will tell you this has a potential for diagnostic error," said Nagarsekar.

When asked about possible irregularities in the award of contract, Nagarsekar noted that the Health Department, in a last minute rejection, pointed to some additional paper work that could have been cleared within a few days, rather than an outright rejection.

"How did the Bangalore company get approved when it did not participate in the tender process, and when it does not have the necessary certifications? Despite the Prime Minister asking high tech Goa companies like us to Make in India, the end result is we were excluded. This result also defies the processes set up by the Central government, which state that MSMEs like us should be given preference in awarding government contracts," he said.

Kallows found support in the Goa Technology Association (GTA) president Mangirish Salelkar who said, "Goa has some of the finest technology companies delivering world class quality products and services across the globe. It's a shame that the government ignores giving contracts to these local companies. Ghar ki murgi, daal barabar."

Local medical technology company, Kallows Engineering, on Tuesday announced that they have apparently been removed from a Goan programme to provide widespread ECG testing and remote ECG recording across the State. The aim of this programme, STEMI Goa, is to reduce deaths from cardiovascular diseases, and improve survival rates for heart attacks. This apparent removal has occurred after the tender was initially awarded to Kallows, and in spite of the established track record of Kallows' ECG technology used in health programmes and hospitals across India.

Kallows has a totally home grown team of 15 plus engineers, investment from a Goan industrialist, a granted US patent, numerous awards by the Government of India and Goa CM's office among others, and supports many projects larger than STEMI Goa across India.

Kallows is currently working with several luminary heart projects--most importantly, STEMI India, a NGO under the leadership of Dr Thomas Alexander of Coimbatore. STEMI India is pioneer of this type of programme, which STEMI Goa is emulating after extensive lobbying and guidance by Kallows. Kallows has been, and still is, the exclusive technology partner of STEMI India, which is approved by Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR).
