The statement came two days after a standoff in Imphal East's Itham village between the Army and a mob led by women that forced the forces to let go of 12 militants holed up there. "Two pistols, four magazines, ammunition and explosives were recovered," said an official, adding the forces received information that miscreants were trying to smuggle weapons to strifetorn Manipur via Nagaland.

Congress leader and former party president Rahul Gandhi will be visiting Manipur later this week. Besides Imphal, where the state's dominant Meitei community constitutes the majority population, Rahul will also visit Churachandpur, a Kuki stronghold. — TNS

It seeks to subject Indian foreign military sales to the same threshold for oversight and accountability as other key US partners and allies, ensuring that India has streamlined access to the high-end capabilities necessary for its defence.

Indian-American Democratic Congressmen Raja Krishnamoorthi, Ro Khanna and Marc Veasey were joined by Republican Congressmen Andy Barr and Mike Waltz in the US House of Representatives in introducing legislation that will deepen US-India ties. - TNS
