After hearing Senior Advocate Sandeep Sethi and Advocate Pravin Kulkarni for the applicants whereas Senior Advocate PN Rama with Advocate VE Tak for the complainant and Senior Prosecuting Officer Rohit Gupta for the State, CJM observed, "In the present case the recovery of Rs 12,90 crore has not been effected. The investigation of the case is still at infancy and the evidential investigation of the accused is still necessary".

"Through embargo contained under Section 497 CrPC is not attracted but taking into consideration the amount involved in the transaction and larger interests of the general public and State, the accused does not deserve the concession of bail at this stage", the Court said.

"In the present case prima facie there are reasonable grounds for the bail application. Saalinder Gulati and Sardeep Ghosh were investigated by Crime Branch in FIR 352/2018 under Section 420, 120-B RPC on 17.11.2018. Ghosh brothers had duped the complainant namely Navazee Mahajan by entering into an agreement. A deal was struck between the complainant and accused brothers for Rs 26 crore for purchase of prime land situated at Kanyways belonging to the accused brothers out of which Rs 13 crore were paid to the accused brothers by the complainant and as per the agreement the amount had to be deposited by the accused brothers in releasing the land encroached with the bank. However, the accused persons instead of releasing the land mortgaged duped the complainant of Rs 13 crore.
